Model Tips and Suggestions

The following is a compilation of answers to frequently asked questions, as well as tips and suggestions to better assist you in your experience as a model for the diPietro Todd apprenticeship program. Please keep in mind that all of our students follow a specific course throughout the program and that they are all in different sections at any one time. This is an educational platform and instructors may be going through the services step by step, working on very specific techniques. Please allow at least 2 hours for your service.

Booking:

- If someone approaches you while you are waiting about finding an appropriate stylist or colorist, find out their name to keep track of who is helping you.
- Once your appointment has been made, be sure to get the colorist /stylist's name, number, appropriate time to contact (if necessary), and the date of your appointment written down before leaving the salon.
- Find out how long the appointment will take (bringing a snack or a lunch is completely acceptable).

Arriving:

- Check in with the front desk then wait for stylist/colorist.
- Please be prepared to pay with cash or credit card before your appointment.
- Sign a Model Release Form
- Get changed in the dressing area and keep all valuables and belongings with you.

Leaving:

- Book future appointments with stylist and/or colorist before checking out to avoid having to come in on a Monday for bookings.
- Please do not leave the salon until an instructor has inspected the service (students cannot receive credit for their work without an inspection by their instructor).
